NEB-Star Stavanger experiments with both the unlimited model and agile piloting

- Storhaug and Kvernevik Unlimited support people with ideas about how to solve social challenges locally, and who want to start a business.
- Agile piloting is an experiment where selected actors get to test their solutions in real environments, for a limited period.





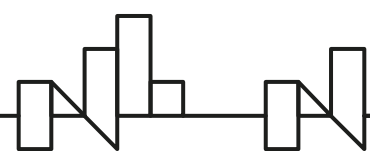
Guitar maker Odd Blikra Egeland, Gitarverkstedet: I want to create a meeting place where people get the opportunity to learn traditional crafts and make their own instrument. The course participants can, for example, be children and young people who do not feel at home in team sports or other organized leisure activities. Or adults who want to work with their hands, meet others in a new arena, and if you are an immigrant, get language training.



Pulsparken: – The area investment at Storhaug will equip the urban space under Bybrua. Here, the municipality will collaborate with social entrepreneurs, voluntary organisations, neighbors and other actors on various participation activities, in order to test out temporary meeting places in urban spaces, project manager of the area initiative at Storhaug.



Nils Christian Fossdal, Elefant theatre: Our premises in Erfjordgata 8 are designed for the very youngest, for children aged 0-5 years. The support and tools from Storhaug Unlimited have helped to create a meeting place for children and families from all walks of life and across cultures.



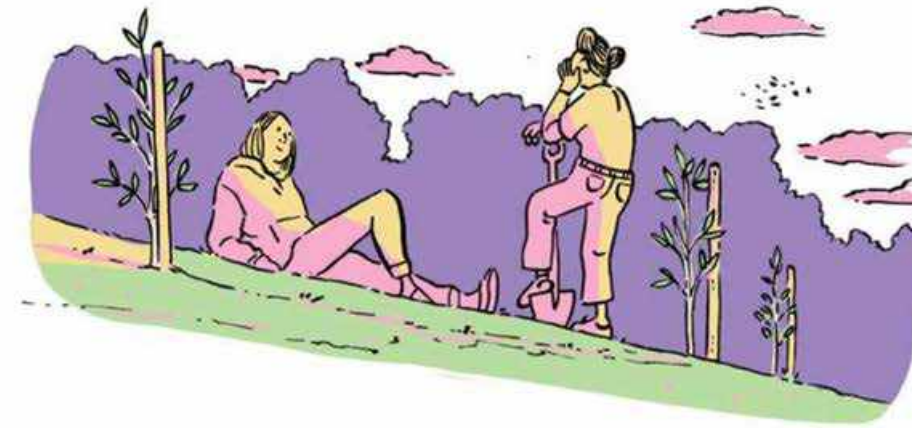
